- Pair of chairs in bamboo stained in imitation of tortoiseshell and rattan seat, late 19th, early 20th century. - This model of cross-braced chair, in the style of Maison Perret & Vibert (Maison des Bambous active from 1879 to 1994), combines various materials: bamboo stained in imitation of tortoiseshell, rattan for the seat and brass at the top of the backrest. These chairs are distinguished by the successful combination of cold and reflective metallic surfaces of brass with the warm textures of bamboo and rattan. - Good condition, wear to be noted on the rattan seat of one of the chairs (see photos) - Dimensions: Height: 95.5 cm, Width: 41.5 cm, Depth: 41 cm
