Exceptional gilt bronze chandelier - 19th century, after André-Charles Boulle Regency style -French work, circa 1870-1880 Magnificent six-light chandelier in finely chiseled and gilded bronze, inspired by the emblematic creations of André-Charles Boulle, undisputed master of ornamentation under Louis XIV. Made in a sumptuous Regency style, this light combines architectural rigor and decorative richness. The central baluster-shaped shaft is adorned with delicate Bérain motifs, gadroons and twisted fluting, and ends with an elegant pine cone as a cushion. The six light arms, in inverted consoles, are magnificently sculpted with foliage and supported by impressive bearded satyr masks, characteristic elements of the Regency decorative vocabulary. The mercury gilding, of remarkable
