Elegance, purity of lines and craftsmanship excellence define this rare vest chain forming a sautoir, signed Cartier, made during the Art Deco period, towards the end of the 1930s. Crafted in 18-carat yellow gold (750?), this collector's item features a marine "anchor chain" link of great finesse, both understated and sophisticated. Weight: 67 g / Length: 93 cm / Link width: 5.3 mm  
It bears the master hallmark of Marcel-François Renard, a renowned Parisian goldsmith, established at 80 rue de Turenne in Paris, active since 1938. Recognized for his exceptional know-how and his collaborations with prestigious houses such as Cartier. Renard surrounded himself with the best craftsmen of his time, thus contributing to the excellence of
