Manuscript copied by the scribe Mohamed Fayegh ibn Mohamed Layesh from the city of Jahanabad, during the Third year of the reign of Emperor Alamgir II. India, Mughal school, part dated 1757. Binding in brown leather with stamped decoration of a golden medallion adorned with poppy flowers, bordered by a frieze of cartouches with floral decoration. Binding detached. 22.5cm X 13.5cm
