He was born in Tokyo in 1925 and died in Paris in 2000. A professional cyclist in Japan, he moved to Paris in 1958 to devote himself entirely to painting. His abstract compositions are marked by the notions of flight, light, air and space, and are characterized by their bright and numerous colors.
