

## Edwardian Daisy Ring In 18k Yellow Gold Set With Old European Cut Diamonds

## Description

This delicate Edwardian daisy ring features a central Old European cut diamond (approx. 0.15 ct), surrounded by twelve smaller, similarly cut diamonds, all set in a finely openworked 18K yellow gold setting. Made circa 1900-1910, this diamond flower reflects the romanticism of the period and the skill of open metal needle techniques, allowing light to penetrate each stone. The fine gold band, hallmarked "750," bears a light patina consistent with its age, while the diamond cluster is mounted in white metal to maximize their brilliance. Sized French 54 (? US 6¾) and fully resizable, the ring weighs 4.60 g; it offers comfortable wear while maintaining the authenticity of an antique piece. The surface condition is excellent, with only light micro-scratches and no chips or repairs. Style:
