In white-glazed porcelain with extensive gilding. 15.3cm (6in) high.Maker's Marks: Faint incised "JO" or "JP" in the centre of the base. Incised or impressed number "28" in one corner. In the opposite corner, another very faint incised or impressed 3-figure number (unreadable). Gilt "24" on the inner side of the base. Condition: Excellent - near mint. No damage, wear or restoration. The stopper fits well. The underside rim of the base is slightly grubby. Shipping: Free to most destinations worldwide.
