Schlessinger 1881 Dim without frame 46/56 Dim with frame 66/75 Sculpted and gilded frame This portrait represents a young woman in bust, in profile, her face resting on her hand, in a calm and introspective attitude. The artist highlights the softness of her features and the elegance of her outfit: a blue satin garment, edged with dark fur, a white muslin bodice and several bracelets on her wrist. The work on the textures is careful, particularly in the rendering of the fabrics and jewelry. The soft light highlights the complexion of the face, detached against a dark and neutral background. Léopold Schlessinger, of German origin, was active in Paris in the second half of the 19th century. A student of Franz Xaver
