Each stone is prong-set in a tightly packed pavé setting, creating a sparkling tiled effect that catches and reflects the light from every angle. The band's generous width combines a strong presence with elegant comfort, making this piece a true signature piece, worn alone or with a thinner wedding band for a stunning stacked effect. The warm hues of the gold and the precision of the setting reflect the French artisanal excellence of the 1970s-1980s, while the timeless geometry guarantees a charm that transcends fashions.
