(Nicolaus Schaaf was a German knife maker from Solingen, who came to Russia in 1820 to work in Zlatoust. After, he moved to St Petersbugh to open his proper bussines in knife making with his son; He was one of the best knife makers and sold many items to the Tsarist family, many officers of the russian army and people of nobility.
