The model is seen three-quarters, in an elegant and natural pose, with beautiful light work on the face. The expression is soft, almost smiling, which gives the whole a real presence. The painting is of good quality, fine and well preserved, with careful details in the face and hair. The copper support, very popular in the 18th century, gives brilliance to the colors and great finesse of execution. Painted around 1750-1780, this small portrait on copper reflects the 18th century taste for intimate and sensitive representations. At a time when the

individual was taking a new place in society, these works were often commissioned to mark a key moment in life: passage to adulthood, commitment or family memory. The cabinet format and the refined copper support reinforce the personal and precious character of this painting. The blackened wooden frame and gilded threads perfectly highlight the portrait.
