Description

Oil on copper depicting Christ on the Cross dating from the 18th century. Central European School, probably Germany or Poland, anonymous artist. Description This painting depicts the crucifixion of Christ, an emblematic scene in Christian art. Jesus is nailed to the cross, his gaze lowered, surrounded by a golden light symbolizing his holiness. At his feet, we notice a human skull, a classic symbol of Golgotha ("place of the skull") and of death conquered by Christ's sacrifice. In the background, a dark landscape with a castle with pointed towers evokes a medieval and dramatic atmosphere. This painting, probably of Baroque or Mannerist inspiration, mixes religious symbolism and architectural details to reinforce the spiritual intensity of the scene. Format with frame 30.5 cm
