Superb burlwood, gold, and tortoiseshell snuff box. The oval burlwood box is enhanced on the edge of the lid and base with a tortoiseshell border, themselves highlighted with a painted black border. The body is also painted with large oval cartouches enlivening the snuff box. The interior is plated with tortoiseshell. A large gold mount, contrasting with the dark tortoiseshell, enhances this box. It is hallmarked: . Bull mark: 3rd standard, 750/°°; Paris 1819-38. Head mark of Sardanapalus (last king of Assyria), guaranteeing large gold works for the same period. Goldsmith's mark to identify: CIP (?) Magnificent box made of precious materials. Understated at first glance, it reveals itself full of charming, refined details once held in your hand. 8.4 x 6.2 cm 2.6 cm high 74.07 grams gross.
