



## Imposing 19th Century Scrimshaw Watch Holder Made From Two Sperm Whale Teeth

### Description

Superb scrimshaw watch-holder composed of two sperm whale teeth representing the same English three-masted ship port/starboard, all sails set. The central part of the watch-holder is made of whalebone mounted on wood, topped with a crown and decorated with flowers and scrolls. The whole rests on a double oval wooden base supported by five whalebone feet. Dimensions: length of +/- 32 cm x height of +/- 22 cm. England made in the middle of the XIXth century.
