Exceptional set of five nesting boxes in solid silver and enamel. The boxes are round, with plain silver handles. The lids are guilloché with a radiating wave pattern. Each lid is enameled with a translucent enamel, the rim highlighted with a line of opaque white or translucent blue enamel. From largest to smallest, the boxes are enameled: Duck egg blue with white border. Pearly white with blue border. Purple with white border. Pink with white border. Green with white border. The interior of the boxes is silver gilt. Each box is hallmarked with a weevil for foreign silver imported into France. The smallest is also hallmarked: Goldsmith's mark: MM with a wheel surmounted by a star for Martin Mayer. Martin Mayer was a German goldsmith active since 1888. He is known for the quality of his objects,
