Born into a family of artists, he developed a passion for painting at a very young age and entered the École des Arts Appliqués in Paris in 1955. In 1960, he entered the École Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris. Although influenced by Cézanne, Braque, and Dufy, Claude Gaveau was also inspired by music and lyricism. He quickly gained recognition in the art world. In 1965, he held his first solo exhibition in a Parisian gallery. Internationally known and recognized, Claude Gaveau's works are often acclaimed.
