Description

Superb ceremonial armchair, dating from the end of the 18th century / beginning of the 19th century, made of richly carved and gilded beech. It features a rectangular backrest slightly inclined towards the rear, known as a "crooked" backrest, straight armrests with cuffs resting on curved uprights with rectangular stops, saber-shaped hind legs, and front legs carved in the shape of horns of plenty. The ornamental repertoire--composed of laurel branches, palmettes, rosettes, acanthus leaves, and small flowers--is fully in keeping with the aesthetic of this transitional period. The belts decorated with clasps reinforce this stylistic lineage, evoking the productions of the major cabinetmakers of the period, notably Pierre-Benoît Marcion, Pierre-Antoine Bellangé, and Jacob Desmalter.
