Made of the same beaten bark, it hides the sex with a white corolla and adorns the dancer with a tail. The base transforms this costume element into a decorative object with a very contemporary design. Tapa (beaten paper mulberry bark), bamboo, wood, recycled rubber, plant fibers. Traces of use.
