Signed Shoko Takebe, with the name "Thomas B. Blow" inscribed in katakana. Published in the volume "Selezione 2024".

Meiji period, circa 1900

Thomas B. Blow was an English merchant who lived in Japan. He supplied many collectors in Europe. His connection to Shoko Takebe is unknown, but his name appears exclusively on Takebe's works.
