company, squadron or battery, four firearms of the models in service, to train young soldiers in disassembly and reassembly. These weapons are part of a special series for each model (the X series); they must never be used for target shooting. "Extract from the regulations: "The corps receive a certain number of firearms (rifles, carbines, muskets or revolvers) for training purposes. These weapons, which all have the letter X as their serial number, bear neither the manufacture's stamp, nor the director's or controller's hallmarks." Ref : 5793
