Elegant rectangular Chinese cinnabar leather cushion, finely decorated with gold lacquer on a bright red background, typical of the manufactures of imperial China. The object, likely dating from the Qing period (17th-19th centuries), is a perfect example of Asian decorative art, intended for domestic use in aristocratic residences or temples. The painted scene depicts a traditional architectural landscape, with human figures in ceremonial dress, a pagoda or pavilion, and natural elements (trees, hills), richly illustrated in gold leaf. These compositions were often symbolic, with references to prosperity, honor, or ancestor worship. The ends of the pillow are adorned with floral and arabesque motifs, framing
