Brutalist Art Deco solid oak sideboard by Charles Dudouyt, 1950s. Charles Dudouyt (1885-1946) was a French designer and cabinetmaker renowned for his bold furniture blending tradition and modernity. Active in the interwar period, he founded his own firm, "La Gentilhommière," in Puteaux, and distinguished himself with a rustic-modernized, highly structured style with powerful volumes. He worked primarily in solid oak, with sculpted finishes, turned legs, and decorative details borrowed from Romanesque or medieval art. His sideboards, armchairs, and tables are particularly prized for their unique character, somewhere between fine craftsmanship and geometric modernism. His work is currently enjoying renewed interest in the vintage design market, particularly in Europe and the United
