Description

This refined 19th-century oil portrait is attributed to the renowned Swedish artist Maria Röhl (1801-1875), known for her elegant and emotionally nuanced portrayals of European society figures. The artwork features a poised gentleman dressed in formal 1830s attire, painted with great care and technical skill. His black coat and high collar contrast beautifully with the soft, gradient background, highlighting his dignified expression and symmetrical features. The lighting and delicate brushwork throughout the piece reflect Röhl's distinct artistic approach. Maria Röhl was a distinguished Swedish portrait artist and one of the most celebrated female painters of the 19th century. Self-taught in her early years, she gained prominence through her lifelike portraits of Sweden's cultural elite. Röhl later studied in Paris under neoclassical master Léon Cogniet, blending Romantic sensitivity with Realist precision. As the court portraitist to the Swedish royal family, Röhl created hundreds of portraits of aristocrats, writers, musicians, and intellectuals. Her works are featured in major collections, including the Swedish Nationalmuseum, and she remains a prominent figure in Scandinavian art history and women's contributions to the arts. Artist:
