Set of two glass gelatin silver bromide negative plates, probably made between the late XIXe century and the 1930s. These photographs depict a naked girl with dwarfism, standing in a medical environment. The postures and framing indicate a desire for precise clinical documentation, for scientific, diagnostic or educational purposes. The style of photography confirms a medical or hospital context typical of university or hospital institutions of the time.Pediatric cases of this kind, treated in such a methodical way, bear witness to both: the clinical anthropometric practices of the time, and the use of photography as a tool for medical and anatomical cataloguing.Each negative is a unique piece of high documentary value, shedding valuable light on hospital practices, the nosological
