In its publisher's binding of dark green cardboard and buckram, smooth spine with gilt, corners of the covers blind-stamped with a flower. Corners slightly bumped, headcaps solid, slight rubbing on the covers. Upper edge gilt (the only one visible in a library when the book is stored upright). Inside sound, slightly foxed (a classic of 19th century paper). The book is easy to handle, despite a slight detachment of the first quire due to its use, which however is still sewn to the entirety of the quires. Slight binding defects from
