Portraits, genre scenes and still lifes, he tried his hand brilliantly at all these styles. He held several exhibitions in Brussels where he lived, and illustrated several literary works. Part of his art lies in caricature, of which a work devoted solely to portraits of musicians was published almost thirty years ago.
