The furniture is inlaid on all sides in rosewood, rosewood, amaranth, and stained boxwood. It presents some of the most famous fables by Jean de La Fontaine (1621-1695): - "The Crow and the Fox" on the central top, - "The Wolf and the Stork" on the right tier, - "The Miller, His Son, and the Donkey" on the central drawer of the tier. - "The Fox and the Stork" on the left drawer of the tier. 19th century, Transition style.
