A little history: Created in 1797, it is the oldest Limoges Porcelain Manufacture still in operation. Founded by François Alluaud, it has successively known several names: as Alluaud porcelain, then c;f;h; (Charles Field Haviland), then GDA for Gérard Dufraisseix and Abbott, and finally Royal. Limoges. The name GDA aD.A. appeared in 1900 with the arrival of Edgart Abbott who was the importer and distributor of the products in
