This antique huge and impressive Chinese porcelain craquelware glazed vase from the 19th century is a stunning example of Nankin style craftsmanship. The elegantly elongated vase features a rounded, bulbous form, resting on a narrow, circular unglazed foot with a recessed base. Its surface is adorned with three continuous bands, each meticulously painted with various figures, framed by delicately incised brown unglazed patterned borders. Its handpainted design features intricate and colorful scenes, depicting figures engaged in traditional activities. The artwork includes finely detailed representations of people, animals, and symbolic motifs that showcase the artistic heritage of the period. The vase itself has a graceful shape, with a wide body that narrows toward the neck. The
