### Description

A large, circa 1795, Meissen porcelain, Marcolini period, twin-handled porcelain basket raised on four Greek key-shaped legs with an oval body of pierced looped sides, the exterior applied in relief with pink roses and a large central leaf with raised square cut handles applied to either end.

The interior is decorated with a hand-painted estuary scene with four flower sprays to the sides.

The underside has an applied central shield-shaped gilded leaf design. Measurements:

excellent condition for age and type. Moderate wear to gilding. Detailed examination reveals a faint 1cm line (actually 2 lines coming from either side but not meeting in the middle) at the foot of one side of a loop (see images). The lines
