

The knobs of the spoons and forks are richly worked in the model of the spatulas, the latter enriched with rocaille shells. The excellence of the master silversmith Emile Puiforcat is recognized by the fineness of the chiseling. Each of the twelve pieces is inscribed with the master's mark (E,P, a desk penknife in a diamond) as well as that of the French guarantee Tête de Minerve 950/1000. All the cutlery, of remarkable quality, is in excellent condition. No wear or deformation, micro-scratches from usual
