Occasional furniture designed for modern post-war domestic interiors.Stamped with the "FR" mark for Fratelli Reguitti.In very good condition.BiographyDomenico "Ico" Parisi (1916-1996) and Luisa Aiani Parisi (1913-1990) were a couple of Italian designers and architects active in post-war Italy.Based in Como, they developed a varied production, ranging from interior architecture to furniture, always driven by a modernist and functional vision of design. Trained in architecture, Ico Parisi first collaborated with Giuseppe Terragni, a figure of
