The front is decorated with the colorful royal coat of arms. This example was intended for use as a fire extinguisher, powered by water from a nearby river or fountain, before the creation of the fire brigade. Beautiful amber shades to the tan leather, superb patina of use and good overall condition. Dimensions: 67 cm with handle / bucket 51 cm x 24 cm / approximately 2.7 kg.
