Cima International "Space Age" fiber optic lampBlack painted cast iron base that contains a 220>12V transformerHemispherical globe in chrome-plated plastic, pierced with dozens of holesFiberglass bundle held by a metal ring, which springs from the top and gradually tints when the lamp is in operation.Small motor + colored filter discThe first examples of this lamp came out around 1968-69, at the height of the "Space Age" design which favored chrome.Cima KG/Cima International was founded by Wolfgang Hochmuth in Nuremberg in 1963.
