His particular style is found in dramatic seascapes, storms, agitated ports, shipwreck scenes. His landscapes are animated by fragile boats, rocky coasts, figures in distress or fishing scenes. He excels in the representation of the agitation of the sea, tormented clouds and striking light effects. Some of his works are in major French museums
