The sculpture represents a large hen carved in wood, made with great craftsmanship.

The crest and wattle are worked with a hammered texture that adds depth and realism to the figure.

The wood used has a warm and natural finish that enhances the grain, giving an elegant and rustic look at the same time.

The dimensions are quite large, it is 45.5 cm high,
