These mirrors are 2 meters and 37 centimeters high; they are huge and fabulous! Not quite a pair, but very impressive and attributed to Gillow's of Lancaster by Sotheby's. Made in the 1840s, they have an oval-bordered, darted frame with carved moldings. These George IV giltwood mirrors have been carefully restored and are very elegant. They both retain their original nameplates. Please examine all our photos carefully to see the slight difference in the basic decoration of this pair. Provenance: Collection of Dunvegan Castle, Isle of Skye, Scotland. The castle dates from the 1200s, and building work goes back several centuries to the 1850s, when these mirrors were made.
