Large Burmese Adoration Moggallana in lacquered and gilded wood, Burma (Myanmar), Kaunbong period (1752-1885), late 19th century. The back of the monastic robe, which normally trailed slightly on the ground, has long since disappeared, but the rest of the work is in very good condition. A comparable example is exhibited at the Asian Art Museum of San Francisco under inventory number B60S599 (The Avery Brundage Collection), Gallery 11. Provenance: Claude de Marteau Collection.
