Austere and sober portrait without jewelry or fancy except for the rich lace on the black fabric of the dress, lace and black fabric which were very expensive at the time. We can therefore think that this portrait represents a rich bourgeois woman from the Flemish 17thcentury. On the other hand, the hairstyle is more in the style of the 16th .Frame from a later period.Light old restorations
