Nancy School after Louis Majorelle: Superb center bed in burl and mahogany, Art Nouveau period, circa 1900, with an atypical and generously animated shape inspired by nature in the spirit of the creations of Hector Guimard (Paris metro stations). The great particularity of the Art Nouveau style, which was born in France in 1889, is that the decorations composed of curves and arabesques are no longer added but are an integral part of the sculpture. The exuberance of the forms, decorations and stylized sculptures earned the nickname "L'art nouille" at this time. Museum piece of high quality cabinetmaking. H127 x 164 x 201 cm.
