Interesting oil on canvas mounted on a wooden panel representing the triumph of Silenus. A very beautiful bacchanalian scene animated by numerous characters: Silenus appears wearing a crown of vine branches, a cup in his hand and riding an ox. He is surrounded by bacchantes and satyrs dancing and playing musical instruments, all in a bucolic landscape. This oil on canvas is brightly colored and is also original because of its oval shape. The features of the characters are slightly sketched as if it were a preparatory study for a larger painting. The canvas is in good condition and has some small paint losses at the level of the angel placed at the top of the composition in the sky. The canvas was mounted on a wooden panel. It is presented in a pretty Napoleon III stucco and gilded wood frame
