On the sides are two ears in the form of knotted ropes, and on the lid sits a Fo dog, called Komainu in Japan. Satsuma, Japan, Meiji era (1868-1912). Signature for identification. Height 52 m, width 28 cm, depth 25 cm. Good condition, one of the ears has a glued crack, the lion's tail is damaged, the edge of the lid is chipped. Free shipping within the European Union!
