A sublime example of 19th-century French jewelry refinement, this ring is crafted in 18K yellow gold and features a deep garnet of approximately 2 carats. The intense red center stone is delicately surrounded by a halo of seventeen rose-cut diamonds (total ? 0.70 ct), whose muted sparkle enhances the piece's antique charm. The goldsmith's work is also revealed in the openwork oxidized under the head and the split band, which visually lighten the ring while emphasizing its feminine elegance. A testament to the romantic style of the era, this heritage jewel makes a timeless engagement ring, a refined cocktail ring, or an exceptional treasure for collectors of historic jewelry.
