Description

Refined 19th-century multiple reliquary from France, crafted in the devotional aesthetic. Made of fabric, paperoles, and fine glass bead inlays, it contains the relics of four saints: the Holy Virgin, Saint Cyriacus, Saint Martha, and Saint Clare.

The relics are elegantly arranged within a five-pointed star structure -- a symbol of protection and spirituality -- topped with three fabric rosettes that complete the ritual and ornamental arrangement.

The overall appearance of the piece is delicate and liturgically intentional: every element, from the curves of the rolled paper to the glints of the beads, speaks of intimate devotion and sacred craftsmanship.
