What makes this object truly unique is its shape: the reliquary was fashioned in a silhouette that explicitly recalls a vulva. This bold and evocative compositional choice transforms the liturgical item into a powerful allegory of generation, embodied spirituality, and the fine line between the sacred and the profane. It likely originates from a monastic or conventual context, representing a devotional aesthetic in dialogue with the feminine
