Description

Pair of candlesticks in cassolette and onyx, gilt bronze, Louis XVI style. Circa 1850. The base is composed of three sabot feet on a base with pearl threads. The central baluster is in onyx, decorated with acanthus leaves topped with rams' heads. The lid is reversible with a decoration of pine cones topped with an onyx lid. On the other, a candlestick decorated with a frieze of acanthus leaves and pearls Height x Width = 20 x 8 cm. Excellent condition, mid-19th century. The advantages of this object: - the onyx which replaces the marble - the quality of the gilding - the very good conditions,
