Emile Tessier was a famous earthenware maker from Malicorne, in the Sarthe department in France. Malicorne-sur-Sarthe is a small town renowned for its earthenware production since the 18th century. Emile Tessier is known to have been a master potter and a talented earthenware maker in the region. Malicorne earthenware is a type of decorative ceramic that has been made in the region for centuries. Local artisans, including Emile Tessier, used traditional techniques to create finely crafted earthenware pieces,
