BIOGRAPHY: Berthe Morisot born in 1841 in Bourges and died in 1895 in Paris, is a French painter, co-founder and dean of the avant-garde movement that was Impressionism. Within the Impressionist group, she arouses the admiration and respect of her peers. Berthe Morisot is a "rebel". Turning her back on academic teaching at a very young age, she founded with Claude Monet, Auguste Renoir, Alfred Sisley, Camille Pissarro, Edgar Degas the avant-garde group "Artistes Anonymes Associés", which will become the Anonymous Society of Painters, Sculptors and Engravers bringing together Impressionists.
