A small plaque on the front: THE TWO RATS AND THE EGG By DE LAFONTAINE Antoine AIGON or Antonin AIGON was born on Febrery 10, 1837 in Montpellier and died on December 3, 1884 in Paris is a French sculptor. He is known for his animal sculptures.
