Description

Pair of 9-arm gilt bronze sconces with Rocaille-style decoration. These sconces are scrolled. They are composed of curves and counter-curves, decorated with acanthus leaf and volute motifs. Under Louis XV, bronze allowed for great imagination in rocaille ornaments, emphasizing the movement of the compositions. These sconces echo the finesse of bronze chiseling under Louis XV. In the style of Jacques Caffieri (1678-1755). Louis XV style - Second half of the 19th century. These sconces are in perfect condition; they have been cleaned and rewired. Highlights: - the very impressive size- the 9 light branches, quite unusual- the quality of the original gilding and fine chiseling- the perfect condition, particularly the wiring.
